

Romans 2:5-11 - Principles for God's Perfect Judgment.

- I. God's Perfect Judgment Is According to a Person's Deeds - Romans 2:5-8.
 - A. God's judgement brings God's wrath - Ro 2:5-6.
 1. God's wrath is deserved: stubbornness & unrepentant - 2:5a.
 2. God's wrath is stored - 2:5b.
 3. God's wrath is certain: day of wrath - 2:5c.
 4. God's wrath is just: righteous judgment - 2:5d.
 5. God's wrath is proportional: according to deeds - 2:6.
 - B. God's judgment falls on one of two paths - Ro 2:7-8.
 1. The path of salvation: God's favor - 2:7.
 - a. Salvation path actions: persevere in doing good - 2:7a.
 - b. Salvation path goal (motivation): seeking God's glory, pursuing honor, & immortality (living in light of eternity) - 2:7b.
 - c. Salvation path reward from God: eternal life - 2:7c.
 2. The path of self-serving: God's frown - 2:8.
 - a. Self-service path goal (motivation): self-serving - 2:8a.
 - b. Self-service path actions: don't obey the truth & obey unrighteousness - 2:8b.
 - c. Self-service path reward: wrath & indignation - 2:8c.
- II. God Perfect Judgment Is Completely Impartial - Romans 2:9-11.
 - A. God's judgment judges religious people first - Ro 2:9-10.
 1. The effects of God's judgment on the self-serving (evil): soul tribulation & distress - 2:9.
 2. The effects of God's judgment on the saved (good): glory, honor, & peace - 2:10.
 - B. God's judgment judges impartially - Ro 2:11.
