

My Dear Loved Ones:

In Psalm 103:7, God says, “He made known His ways to Moses, / His acts to the children of Israel.”

Moses asked to see God’s glory in Exodus 33:13; God gave Him an answer in Exodus 34:6, 7 - “The Lord passed before him and proclaimed, “The LORD, the LORD, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness, 7 keeping steadfast love for thousands...” Notice: Moses want’s to see God’s glory. God responds with declaring things about Himself. These attributes that God declares, are the same attributes that we hear right now declared to us - these are God’s glory to be seen by us. Many people have said in life that they would like to see God. If you want to see Him, stop and listen to these characteristics, and think about them - that is the same as seeing them!

God’s ways and acts aren’t just displayed in Israel being delivered miraculously through many miracles in Egypt, the crossing of the Red Sea, and then the travel through the wilderness and God providing manna to eat. God’s law was given to Moses and God’s people at Mount Sinai. It shows God’s nature and God’s will for His people.

Deuteronomy 8:2 says that God did the things of the Exodus and wilderness wanderings to “make you know.” It wasn’t just bare information; it was the training of sons to get to know God.

I wonder: do we know God? Do we know Him and the attributes that He reveals? We only trust someone that we know really well. I supposed you could say that our trust and dependence demonstrates whether we really know God or not. Again, it’s not just filling our head with things. It’s in our hearts and affections, too.

Loved ones, He’s got us. We can trust Him. He’s proven Himself over and over again.
