I began to collect my thoughts and talk to the Lord, because I knew that He alone had the answer to my problems. After prayer, I sat at the piano and just doodled with chords as my heart was still talking to God. Then the thought that 'Jesus never fails' came to me. I wrote the chorus first, then a verse (I originally wrote the second verse as the first one). When I finished, a peace settled on my heart. I knew that the God Who never fails would find an answer. Just then a knock came at the door of someone with a telegraph message that my son came through the crisis and all is well."
